The Right to Life League of Southern California is happy to announce Lila Rose, president and founder of *Live Action*, as 2011 Benefit Dinner guest speaker.

Lila Rose, at age fifteen, founded *Live Action*, a youth-led nonprofit organization. *Live Action* works to expose abuses in the abortion industry and advocates for human rights for the pre-born by using new media to educate and mobilize both local and national audiences.

Lila Rose is on fire for LIFE and her organization is responsible for uncovering countless atrocities executed by Planned Parenthood, the nations largest abortion provider.

Again and again, her team of undercover reporters have caught on tape illegal activities, as well as morally reprehensible practices, that Planned Parenthood, it would seem, is committing.

The pro-life community is finally on the offensive; and because of *Live Action's* efforts, the issue of abortion is in the news, exposing truth and forcing organizations like Planned Parenthood to defend their practices and answer for their lies.



Through undercover reporting, along with the pro-life student magazine, "The Advocate", and Lila's frequent guest appearances on radio, television, and international pro-life speaking engagements, *Live Action* is defending the next generation.

This event will be a record setter! Currently 291 locations have signed on: 48 states, Washington DC and Puerto Rico, 7 Canadian provinces, Australia, England, Spain and for the first time, Germany and Argentina; 46 first-time campaign cities!

Celebrate Margaret Sanger's Birthday!

Who is Margaret Sanger? Founder of Planned Parenthood, her mission was 'birth control', a phrase she is credited as coining around 1914. Through her campaign for contraception, she was incredibly gifted at tying her causes, and herself, to like issues in news, and keeping them there.

In the mid 1920s she united herself to the eugenicists, taking on the mission which was to encourage high reproductive rates in social classes that were deemed 'desirable' while eradicating reproduction in undesirable classes. *"Birth control must lead ultimately to a cleaner race."* *


VOICE:

At High Desert Pregnancy Clinic the volunteers and staff pray each morning, before opening. The group lifts up in prayer those who are abortion minded, that God might change their hearts. On one particular morning, the volunteer client advocate also prayed for those who are suicidal, an unusual addition. As morning prayer ended, Laura Jensen, the Center Director, said, “Be ready for that client.”

Late in the afternoon, the volunteer, who had prayed that morning, went to Laura’s office with tears in her eyes. “God is so good!” The client advocate went on to explain that her client, a young man, had been despondent — questioning life, especially his own. He began to ask questions about God. He was discouraged about having no job, affording a child, and feeling God had abandoned him, his girlfriend and the baby she was carrying.



The client advocate used this opportunity to share God’s love and pointed out even Jesus felt abandoned as He hung on the cross. They prayed together, and the young man was encouraged and knew that he wasn’t alone. The baby will be born in a few short months, and the baby’s father will be open to love, as shown through the compassion of the volunteer at the clinic, and as God the Father has loved him.
