Planned Parenthood has been accepted to work on the grounds of Theodore Roosevelt High School in Los Angeles.

According to the Roosevelt High School website, "...RHS [Roosevelt High School students] students can be referred to the Peer Advocate Program based out of the Boyle Heights Office," where "RHS students that have been selected and trained by Planned Parenthood" will "provide outreach and education to fellow RHS students on teen pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections, and other concerns related to teen sexuality."*

SB 623



passed another round of voting in a 52-26 vote.

Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2008): 24%

In 2008, 897,700 women in California became pregnant. 61% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 24% in induced abortions

Total Abortion Facilities (2008): 522

In 2008, the Alan Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 522 abortion providers in California. There were 424 providers in 2005 and 400 providers in 2000.

Abortion Restrictions (2011):

- California does not have any of the major types of abortion restrictions—such as waiting periods, mandated parental involvement or limitations on publicly funded abortions—often found in other states.





prayers are needed! Serene is under 20 years old and in a relationship for some time. Her boyfriend and her want to get married, but do not feel like the timing is right. Still, they had sex and she realized after missing her period that she may be pregnant.



When she first visited, her pregnancy test came up positive. It was too soon to have an ultrasound, which is typically offered at 7-15 weeks. She is studying abroad and currently has no family or support system nearby. We assured her that they were there for her. She could come in for any reason at all and anytime. Even if she just needed a hug, she was welcome to stop by. And so, she continued to stop by and share with us how she was doing. A few weeks later, she came back again and we offered her a free ultrasound. She decided to go through with it. At this point, we realized she had a strong faith but with this came shame. She was worried that she would lose her family's support and help with her education if she had the baby. After talking it out, though, she left and came back a few weeks later. Her question this time was about the adoption process. We assured her that we were here to answer any questions at all and offered to schedule a call with our adoption services contact and be there with her.
